Let if affected or stroke if prevented



TURNING

Expanded definition. Clarifies outcomes of interference



CONDITIONS OF PLAY

New details on wet patches, fallen objects, distractions



TIMING & INJURY ADJUSTMENTS

1min between warm-up and play


